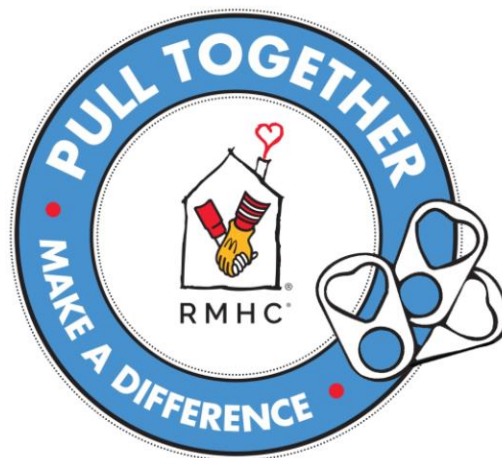
## Exploratory Committee Being Formed
