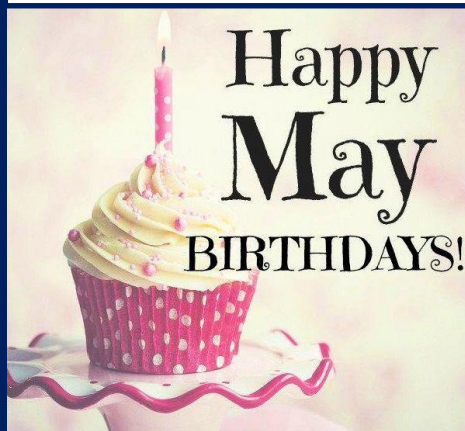
Lerch's DONUTS
