- Partnering with OMA to implement the Ohio Manufacturing Workforce Partnership's \$12 million USDOL Scaling Apprenticeship grant:
 - July 15, 2019 June 30, 2023
 - Goal of training 5,000 apprentices
 - 11 industry-led sector partnerships covering all of Ohio's 88 counties
 - Ohio TechNet's continued partnership with the Ohio Manufacturers' Association (OMA) remains aligned to and focused on advancing OMA's <u>2020 Workforce Roadmap</u>
- Continued engagement with the Manufacturing USA network.
- Advancing innovation tied to Industry 4.0 which represents the convergence of technology and IT with manufacturing.






Kelly springs into action, mobilizing the OTN consortium to problem solve together.






Layoffs and furloughs created challenges in keeping Earn & Learn programs moving.
